Improve medical services for victims of human trafficking

Association Pro Refugiu organized in Bucharest between 1 October 2015-3October 2015 a training for doctors and medical assistants, as part of the project *PRO HEALTH –Improve medical services for victims of human trafficking,* financed through EEA Grants 2009-2014, NGO Fund in Romania. One of the project's objectives consists in creating a national network of specialists able to provide medical assistance for victims of human trafficking. The topics approached during the training were: physical and psychological human trafficking consequences; PTSD; pathologies associated with human trafficking; victims profile; basic principles in health care; doctor-patient confidentiality; doctors working in a multidisciplinary team; the national and EU legal framework regarding the medical assistance to which victims are entitled.
