Empower migrant women and promote reframing of gender-sensitive integration policies
(POWERING)

The Stuttgart Region Economic Development Corporation/Wirtschaftsförderung Region Stuttgart GmbH develops regional business and coordinates all activities related to this matter. Its strategic tasks include: active marketing of the region on national and international level, acquiring companies, investor services, supporting start-ups, promotion of regional technology and innovation networks, as well as measures to counteract the lack of specialists.

It organizes informational events and networks for several migrant groups, together with the labour market partners from Skilled Personal Alliance in the Stuttgart region (e.g. for migrant women). Furthermore, it builds networks to promote labour market integration and the welcome culture in the region.

The Stuttgart Region Economic Development Corporation expresses its support for the project to empower migrant women and promote reframing of gender-sensitive integration policies (POWERING), Asylum Migration and Integration Fund (AMIF), Social and Integration of Migrant Women AMIF-2019-AG-CALL-03.
